Opportunities Include:

- Preparing Al-Anon public outreach materials for distribution: apply stickers, count, collate, bundle, etc.
- Delivering materials to professional offices, libraries, and other locations in our communities.
- Be on the lookout and/or actively search out health fairs, awareness events, etc. where the District 48 Al-Anon booth could have a presence to inform the public about what Al-Anon offers.
- Set up, tend, take down, and/or transport the District 48 Al-Anon information booth for scheduled events
- Work with and through social media outlets to spread Al-Anon's message
- Help spread the Al-Anon message through billboards, kiosks, digital windows, and more
- Be a public outreach speaker who goes to local addiction recovery centers and other public venues to talk about "how Al-Anon works for friends and families of alcoholics"
- Seek out recovery centers and public venues and approach them about having an Al-Anon speaker
- Coordinate speakers for these events
- Assist in planning the Hope Gala—District 48's annual public outreach fund raiser.
- Join the Public Outreach Committee and attend the meetings
- Join a subgroup of the Public Outreach Committee to work on special projects.
